

PrePay and save!

Introducing route 448 - the new weekday peak hour express PrePay Only bus route between City (QVB) and Pyrmont. Route 448 is a prepaid ticket-only service for faster passenger boarding time and better on-time reliability of services.

- **No tickets are sold on the bus. Please buy your ticket before you travel.** Ticket agents nearest to the bus route are listed in this brochure.
- Remember: prepaid bus tickets can also be used on other Sydney Buses services.

Route 448 PrePay tickets

Pyrmont - City (QVB) is a two section fare trip

TravelTen

If you travel by bus only from where you live to the City and on to Pyrmont, it is best to get a TravelTen for each leg of your trip.

- TravelTen is a ticket with 10 rides – save up to 20% on the cost of Single Ride tickets.
- Can be kept indefinitely – expire only after 10 rides have been used.
- Can be used to pay for a companion – just dip the ticket twice

TravelPass

If you travel by train or ferry from where you live to the City then to Pyrmont by route 448, it is best to get a TravelPass to use on all legs of your trip.

- Ideal for trips that require frequent travel by train, bus or ferry or any combination of these transport modes.
- Unlimited travel* (including transfers) over seven consecutive days on Sydney Buses, CityRail and Sydney Ferries regular services within the zone(s) covered by the ticket.
- Different types are available depending on time period, zones covered and modes of transport used – bus and ferry or train, bus and ferry.

Single Ride Ticket

Prepaid Single Ride tickets are available for trips to new or other than your regular destination. Make sure you buy two tickets for a return trip.

Pensioner Excursion Ticket

- Unlimited all day travel* on Sydney Buses, Newcastle Buses & Ferries, Sydney Ferries, CityRail and participating private buses around Sydney, Newcastle and outer metropolitan areas.
- Ticket is available to holders of valid pensioner concession, seniors and war widow/er cards.

*Note: *Excludes travel on Explorer Buses, Ferry Cruises, JetCats, special event, charter or private buses and on CityRail's AirportLink services to Green Square, Mascot, Domestic and International Airport stations. An access fee is required to use the Airport Line and can be paid when you buy your DayTripper or Pensioner Excursion Ticket.*

Where to buy your ticket

Look for the Sydney Buses PrePay flag on display at ticket agents.

Ticket agents

Sydney Buses ticket agents are independently-run businesses. The tickets they sell are based on local demand and may run out at anytime. Ticket availability also depends on the order-delivery schedule based on the agent's location. To avail of PrePay only services, please:

- Buy your ticket well before you travel.
- Familiarise yourself with the other ticket agents in your local or neighbouring area, or in the City.
- Keep a spare ticket for urgent use by you or other family members.

- **No tickets are sold on the bus. Buy your ticket from ticket agents or TransitShops before you travel.**
- New weekday peak hour express bus service between QVB (York St) and Pyrmont (Pirrama Rd).
- Services every five minutes in the AM and PM peak hours.
- PrePay can save 20% or more on the cost of Single Ride tickets.
- Timetable, route map, ticket options and list of ticket agents inside.

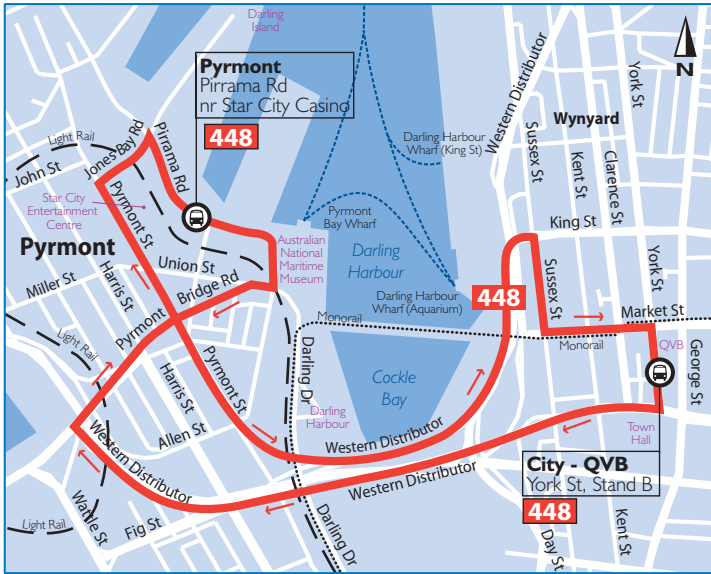




448 Route Map

Pyrmont - City (QVB) express services

Pick-up and set-down stops only at Pyrmont (Pirrama Rd near Star City Casino) and QVB (stand B, York St).

Alternative services

All stops route 443 between Circular Quay and Pyrmont via QVB (stand B) operates seven days from early in the morning to past midnight. Tickets are sold on the bus.

Seniors and PrePay

PrePay makes travel on buses much easier for seniors. Open-dated Pensioner Excursion and concession Single Ride tickets are now sold at TransitShops in the City and ticket agents along the PrePay routes. Seniors can buy these tickets well before their trip. They should validate their ticket in the green ticket reader on the bus when they travel.

Use the right ticket

Revenue Protection Officers travel on Sydney Buses frequently. There is an on-the-spot fine of up to \$100* or a court-imposed fine of up to \$550* for not having a ticket, using the wrong ticket, overriding or using a concession ticket without a valid concession or authority card.

To avoid fines:

- Concession fare requires a valid concession card or authority – Pensioner; War Widow/Widower; Student Card (Form 204 with Transport Foil on it). Always carry it with you when travelling on a concession ticket.
- Do not use an outdated or fake concession card or authority.
- Check with the bus driver if you are unsure of your ticket's validity for the trip.

Lost property

Please keep your bus ticket for your record of the bus route, time and direction of travel. This will help track your lost property item on the bus. Please phone 131500 for any lost property enquiry.

Travel Safely

- Watch your step when boarding the bus

- For less mobile passengers, use the seats at the front of the bus and exit via the front door.

Fare examples to Pyrmont

If your trip to Pyrmont requires travel on train and bus, or ferry and bus, the best ticket option is a TravelPass. It allows unlimited travel within the zones, time period and transport modes listed on the ticket.
