Alternative services

Ryde – City. Routes 500, 501, 515, X15, 518, X18, 520 and L20 travel along the same route as X00 from the City up to or through Ryde via Victoria Road. Regular services operate from early in the morning to late at night. Tickets are sold on the bus.

East Ryde – City. Route 506 travel along the same route as X06. Tickets are sold on the bus.

Seniors and PrePay

PrePay makes travel on buses much easier for seniors. Open-dated Pensioner Excursion and concession Single Ride tickets are now sold at TransitShops in the City and some ticket agents along the PrePay routes. Seniors can buy these tickets well ahead of their trip. They should validate their ticket in the green ticket reader on the bus when they travel.

PrePay and save

We have converted routes X00 and X06 to prepaid ticket only services to reduce passenger boarding time and help improve the on-time reliability of these services.

- **NO tickets are sold on the bus. Please buy your ticket before you travel. Ticket agents are listed in this brochure.**
- Remember these tickets can also be used on other Sydney Buses services.

Prepay tickets include:

TravelTen

- Ticket with 10 rides – save up to 20% on the cost of single ride tickets.
- Can be kept indefinitely – expire only after all 10 rides have been used.
- Can be used to pay for a companion – just dip the ticket twice.

TravelPass

- Unlimited travel over seven consecutive days by bus & ferry or bus, ferry and train.
- Different types are available depending on zones covered and modes of travel used.
- If you reside in the Ryde or East Ryde area, travel frequently and need to transfer or hop on and hop off between services during trips, a weekly Orange TravelPass (bus and ferry) is the best ticket for you. It permits unlimited travel* on all regular Sydney Buses and Sydney Ferries services over seven consecutive days, within the Sydney Buses Blue and Orange Zones 1 to 8 and all Sydney Ferries Zones.
- For just a little extra, you can get a Green TravelPass which has the same benefits as the Orange TravelPass plus train travel on CityRail services in the area bounded by Bondi Junction, Kogarah, Kingsgrove, Regents Park, Bankstown (via Lidcombe or Sydenham), Epping, Chatswood and Olympic Park stations.

Single Ride Tickets

Prepaid single ride tickets are available for trips to new or other than your regular destination. Make sure you buy two tickets for a return trip.

Pensioner Excursion Ticket

- Unlimited all day travel* on Sydney Buses, Newcastle Buses & Ferries, Sydney Ferries, CityRail and participating private buses around Sydney, Newcastle and outer metropolitan areas.
- Ticket is available to holders of valid pensioner concession, seniors and war widow/er cards.

*Note: *Excludes travel on Explorer Buses, Ferry Cruises, JetCats, special event, charter or private buses and on CityRail's AirportLink services to Green Square, Mascot, Domestic and International Airport stations. An access fee is required to use the Airport Line and can be paid when you buy your DayTripper or Pensioner Excursion Ticket.*

To avail of PrePay only services, please:

- Buy your ticket well before you travel.
- Familiarise yourself with the other ticket agents in your local or neighbouring area, or in the City.
- Keep a reserve of your regular TravelTen ticket for urgent use by you or other family members.

Look for the Sydney Buses Prepay flag on display at ticket agents.



Use the right ticket

Revenue Protection Officers travel on Sydney Buses frequently. There is an on-the-spot fine of up to \$100* or a court-imposed fine of up to \$550* for not having a ticket, using the wrong ticket, overriding or using a concession ticket without a valid concession or authority card.

To avoid fines:

- Concession fare requires a valid concession card or authority – Pensioner; War Widow/Widower; Student Card (Form 204 with Transport Foil on it). Always carry it with you when travelling on a concession ticket.
- Do not use an outdated or fake concession card or authority.
- Check with the bus driver if you are unsure of your ticket's validity for the trip.

Other PrePay only routes

Since October 2006, Sydney Buses has launched PrePay only services on these major bus corridors –

- Circular Quay to Bondi Beach (333)
- Denistone East to the City via the Lane Cove Tunnel (297)
- Abbotsford to Circular Quay via Parramatta Road (L38).
- Northern Beaches to the City via Pittwater Rd & Military Rd (E86, E87, E88, E89)
- Manly & South Curl Curl to the City via Military Rd (E65, E70)

The success of these cashless services has paved the way for the launch of PrePay Only services on all the major bus corridors in the Sydney Buses network by the end of 2007. The major corridors set to benefit from the cashless bus services will be:

- Anzac Parade
- Alison Road (Randwick)
- Victoria Road
- King Street (Newtown)
- Botany Road (Port Botany)
- Eastern Valley Way (Willoughby)
- Willoughby Road (Willoughby)
