State Transit buses link UNSW with Sydney City, suburbs, Sydney Airport and major transport interchanges where you can connect with other train, bus, ferry and light rail services.

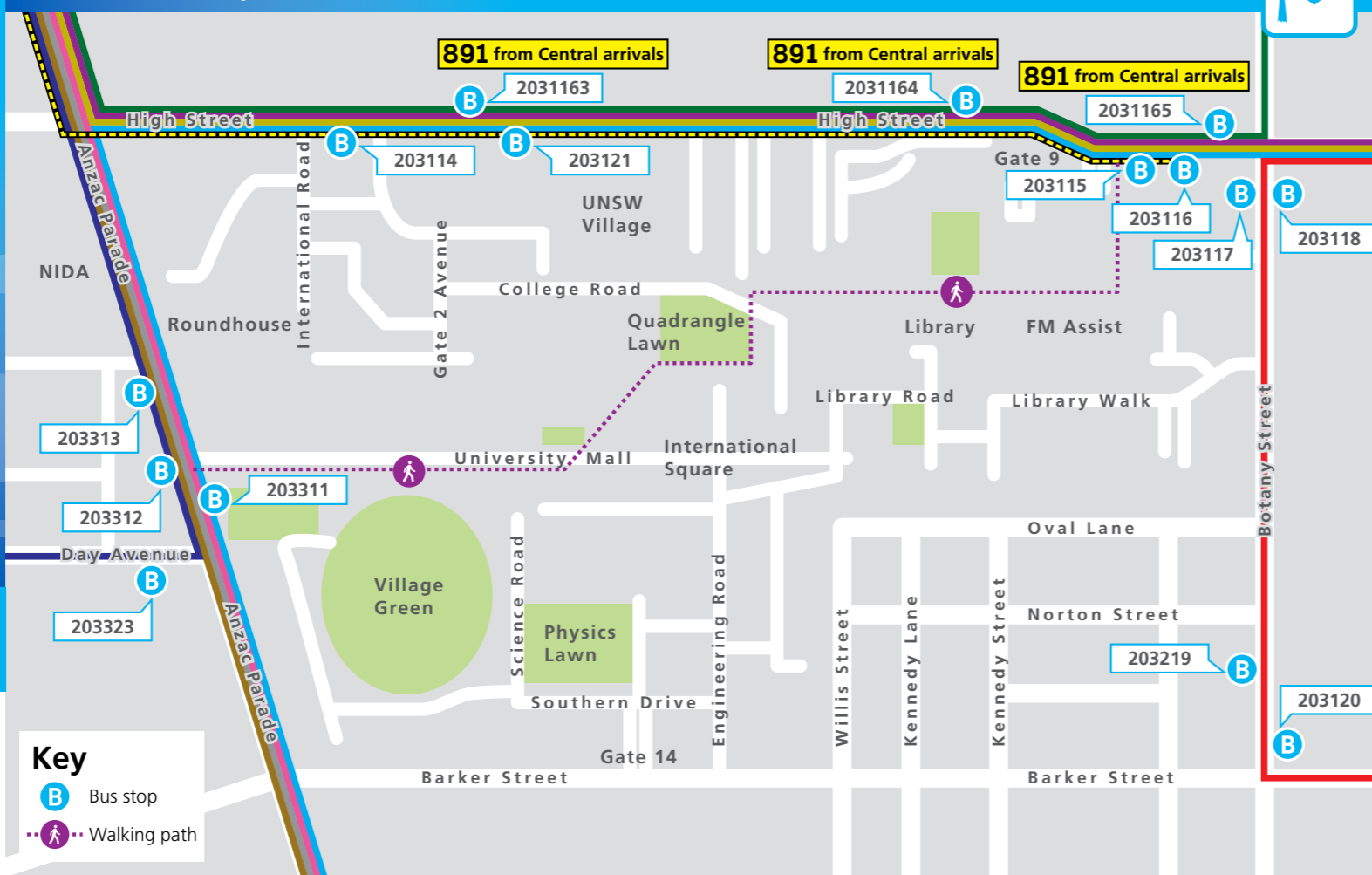
Timetables and maps

Bus route map: UNSW local area

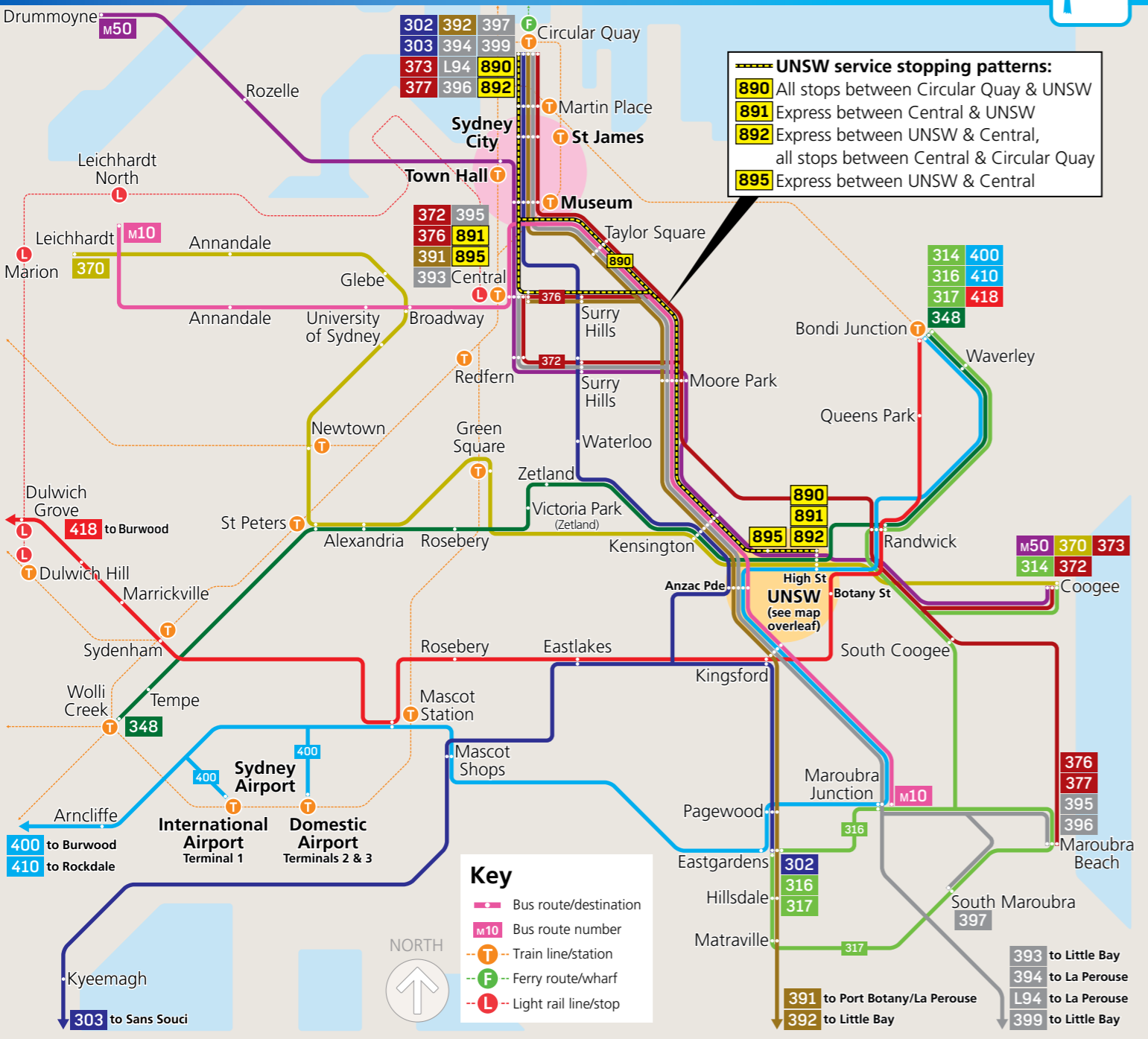

- 892** Express between UNSW & Central, all stops between Central & Circular Quay
- 895** Express between UNSW & Central

Ticketing

Opal is the easy way of travelling on public transport in Sydney, the Blue Mountains, Central Coast, Hunter, Illawarra and Southern Highlands.

An Opal card is a free smartcard you keep and reuse. You load value onto the card to pay for your travel on any mode of public transport including trains, buses, ferries and light rail.

Opal comes with a range of benefits, including:

- Fares capped daily and weekly
- Fares capped at \$2.50 on Sundays
- The option of auto top-up, so you're always ready to travel.

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Services

UNSW is serviced by buses travelling along two of Sydney's major corridors - Anzac Parade and Belmore Road, Randwick Junction. Some routes in this area operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

In addition to regular services, dedicated buses connect UNSW with Central and the City.

The maps above and overleaf can help identify the best service for you, and the closest stop where you can catch it.

UNSW special bus routes
Express routes operate between UNSW and Central Station:

- 891** – between Central and UNSW (High Street) in both directions
- 895** – from UNSW (High Street) to Central

Routes 891 and 895 operate frequently at peak times, during the day, and into the evenings on weekdays.

Additional services also operate at limited times:

- 890** – from Circular Quay to UNSW (High Street), stopping at all stops
- 892** – from UNSW (High Street) to Central and Circular Quay
- 393** – from UNSW (High Street) to Central, stopping at all stops

Exam and UNSW vacation periods
During UNSW exam periods, most of the UNSW special services will divert via Randwick Racecourse. During the UNSW vacation period, buses run to a different timetable with a reduced frequency.

For more information, check the City & Central Station to UNSW bus timetable when you're travelling at this time.

Attractions and entertainment

State Transit's network of buses can get you from UNSW to the main attractions and places of interest in Sydney.

Sydney City
The City has it all, from entertainment experiences, dining, shopping, the arts, cinemas and our famous harbour. The core of the city is situated around Museum, St James and Town Hall stations. Other attractions including The Rocks, the Opera House, ferries and the harbour are located near Circular Quay. Buses between UNSW and Sydney City operate frequently.

Chinatown
You can find some of the best Chinese culture at Sydney's Chinatown. Offering a variety of festivals, shops, history and food, it is an essential visit. The famous Paddy's Markets are also located in Haymarket, right next to vibrant Dixon Street. Chinatown is a short walk from Central Station and close to Museum Station.

Eastern Beaches
The Eastern Suburbs features famous beaches along most of its coastline, all of which are easily accessible by bus:

- You can visit famous **Bondi Beach** by catching a bus to Bondi Junction, and changing for a connecting Route 333 service.
- Nearby **Bronte and Tamarama beaches** also have buses departing from Bondi Junction.
- Coogee Beach** can be directly accessed by catching any Route m50, 370, 372 and 373 service.
- Situated further south, **Maroubra Beach** is served by routes 395, 396, 317, 376 and 377.

Surry Hills
With a great range of shops, businesses, galleries, restaurants and pubs, Surry Hills has a buzzing village atmosphere. Crown Street passes through the centre, and surrounding streets are also worth a look.

Newtown
Renowned for its diverse and unique community, Newtown offers a variety of restaurants, pubs and shops which showcase this vibrant and diverse culture.

Sydney Cricket Ground and Allianz Stadium
A few minutes from UNSW, the Sydney Cricket Ground - or SCG - and Allianz Stadium regularly feature rugby, soccer, NRL, AFL and cricket. Catch a Moore Park bus and alight opposite the venue.

The Entertainment Quarter
Located next to Moore Park and the Sydney Cricket Ground, The EQ features 16 Hoyts cinemas, and a mix of speciality retail outlets, cafes and restaurants.

Sydney Airport
The limited-stops Route 400 stops at Domestic terminals 2 and 3, and International terminal 1. For direct travel, ensure that you board a Route 400 bus travelling towards Burwood.

Shopping

There are also frequent services to the main shopping centres and precincts in the Eastern Suburbs, linking directly to the UNSW campus:

Bondi Junction
The largest shopping area in the Eastern Suburbs, Bondi Junction offers one of the largest Westfield centres in Sydney, while surrounding streets feature a wide range of speciality stores, restaurants and services.

Eastgardens
A large Westfield centre offering department stores, supermarkets, speciality stores and services, as well as restaurants and cinemas.

Randwick Junction
Belmore and Alison roads offer a variety of fresh food, restaurants, supermarkets, speciality stores and essential services.

Maroubra Junction
Pacific Square offers supermarkets, fresh food, casual dining and speciality shops. Additional stores are also along Anzac Parade and Maroubra Road.

Victoria Park, Zetland
The new East Village centre features supermarkets, fresh food, essential services and a health club. Catch Route 348 towards Wolli Creek, or routes 302 or 303 towards the City, and alight at O'Dea Avenue.

IKEA
The huge IKEA Tempe store has a wide selection of value-for-money and functional products for your home. Route 348 towards Wolli Creek will drop you at the door.

Accessibility

Most State Transit buses are wheelchair-accessible with low-level floors and space for wheelchairs, prams or strollers.

To help you work out the right stop to leave your bus, most buses on routes m10 and m50 also feature automatic announcements and display screens, broadcasting details of bus stops, attractions and transport connections.

Customer comfort

Eating, drinking, smoking or playing loud music on the bus is not allowed. By law, smoking is not allowed at any bus stop, or at train stations, ferry wharves or light rail stops.
