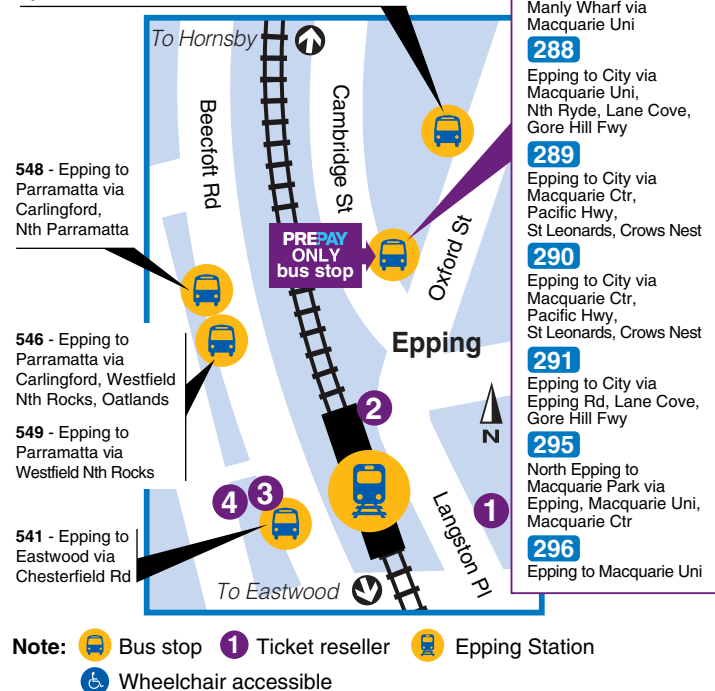

# PREPAY ONLY

- Sydney Buses services at Cambridge St bus stop will not sell tickets on board.
- Buy your ticket before you travel.
- PrePay allows faster passenger boarding at bus stops and better on-time reliability of bus services.
- PrePay multi-ride tickets can save 20% or more compared to single ride tickets.
- Ticket options, destinations, section and fare guide, and list of ticket resellers inside.

## PrePay and save!

We have converted the bus stop on Cambridge St near the corner of Oxford St on the eastside of Epping Station to prepaid ticket-only bus stop to speed up passenger boarding times and help improve the on-time reliability of bus services.

- **PrePay Only at this stop operates from Monday to Friday, 7am to 7pm.**
- **No tickets are sold on the bus.** Please buy your ticket before you travel. Ticket resellers nearest to the bus stop are listed in this brochure.
- Remember: prepaid bus tickets are valid on all Sydney Buses regular services.

## PrePay tickets include:

### TravelTen

- Ticket with 10 rides – save 20% compared to single ride tickets.
- Can be kept indefinitely – expire only after all 10 rides have been used.
- Can be used to pay for a companion – just dip your ticket twice.
- Different types are available depending on the number of sections travelled.



### TravelPass (Weeklies)

- Ideal for trips that require frequent travel by train, bus or ferry or any combination of these transport modes.
- Unlimited travel\* (including transfers) over seven consecutive days on Sydney Buses, CityRail and Sydney Ferries regular services within the zones covered by the ticket.
- Different types are available depending on zones covered and modes of transport used – bus and ferry or train, ferry and bus.

### Single Ride Ticket

- Prepaid Single Ride tickets are available for trips to new or other than your regular destination.

- Make sure you buy two tickets if a return trip is planned.
- For pensioners/ seniors with valid concession/ authority card, a concession single 1-2 section ticket is ideal for short trips. For longer or multiple trips during the day, the Pensioner Excursion Ticket is best.

### Pensioner Excursion Ticket (PET)

- Unlimited all day travel\* on Sydney Buses, Newcastle Buses & Ferries, Sydney Ferries, CityRail and participating private buses around Sydney, Newcastle and outer metropolitan areas.
- Only holders of valid pensioner/ senior concession/ authority cards can buy this ticket.
- Prepaid PET is sold at ticket resellers or TransitShops in the City (except at Railway Square) with no printing on the back of the ticket.
- Prepaid PET can be purchased well ahead of travel. It becomes active on the day of use and must be inserted in the green machine on the bus. The validity date and details of the trip will then be printed on the back of the ticket.
- If the prepaid PET is first used on a CityRail service, the station automatic gates will not print on the back of the ticket. If then used on a Sydney Buses service and inserted in the green machine, the back of the ticket will be printed with the validity date and details of the trip.

**Note:** \*Excludes travel on Explorer buses, ferry cruises, JetCats, special event, charter or private buses and at CityRail's Green Square, Mascot, Domestic and International Airport stations. An additional access fee will have to be paid to get on or off at these stations.

## Use the right ticket

Revenue Protection Officers travel on Sydney Buses frequently. There is an on-the-spot fine of up to \$100\* or a court-imposed fine of up to \$550\* for not having a ticket, using the wrong ticket, overriding or using a concession ticket without a valid concession or authority card.

## Where to buy your ticket *cont...*

### Ticket resellers

- There are around 800 ticket resellers across metropolitan Sydney, including many newsagents. Ticket resellers are independently-run businesses and have their own trading practices, including surcharge on EFTPOS or credit purchases. Ticket availability at these outlets depends on local demand and the order-delivery schedule based on the ticket reseller's location.

### CityRail ticket offices

Most CityRail ticket offices sell TravelTens and weekly TravelPasses valid on Sydney Buses services. The tickets are issued on generic CityRail ticket stock with the ticket details printed at the time of issue. When inserted on the green machine on the bus, the ticket will be printed with the details of the trip. Pensioner Excursion Tickets sold at CityRail ticket offices are active and valid on the day of purchase only.

### TransitShops

There are four TransitShops in the City. Tickets are sold at TransitShops in:

- Circular Quay – cnr Loftus and Alfred Streets; Mon-Fri 7am – 7pm; Sat-Sun 8.30am – 5pm
- Wynyard Station – Carrington Street entrance; Mon-Fri 7.30am – 7pm
- QVB – York Street near bus stand D; Mon-Fri 8am – 6pm

The TransitShop at Railway Square is an information kiosk only.

## Take care of your ticket

- If you buy a number of open-dated tickets at one time, keep the unused tickets separate from the one you are using to avoid confusion.

- Please take note when using your Pensioner Excursion Ticket on CityRail services because the validity date is not printed on the back when inserted in the station's automatic gates.
- Except for faulty tickets, Sydney Buses does not replace damaged (folded, torn) tickets.

## Lost property

Keep your bus ticket for a record of the bus route, time and direction of your travel. This will help track your lost property item. Please phone 131500 for any lost property enquiry.
